Three trends shaping the future workplace

Three main trends will influence what the future workplace will look like.

1

Virtual communication and collaboration

The U.S. number of fully and remote and hybrid knowledge workers will account for 71% of the U.S. workforce in 2023.¹ This number is expected to grow as many employees are willing to leave their current roles to find an employer that can offer the flexibility needed to achieve their desired work-life balance.

As businesses implement and refine their hybrid work options for their employees, they will recognize that there will be an increase in virtual communication and collaboration. Since February 2020, the number of Microsoft Teams calls and meetings increased by three times.²

Organizations that rely solely on email or disparate collaboration systems will struggle as it will impact their employees' ability to access their work and efficiently collaborate with their colleagues in and out of the office. In turn, there will be delays, errors, and miscommunications that can negatively impact the organization's quality of work and reputation with customers.

From Q3 to Q4 of 2022, there was a 142% increase in vishing attacks.⁴ These data threats will only increase as the workforce becomes more digital.








Protect, control, and manage access to data
